# Classroom Maestro

## Orchestra Edition Shortcuts

Welcome to Classroom Maestro Orchestra Edition!

Classroom Maestro is your musical servant, ready to display single notes, intervals, scales, chords, chord progressions, and keyboard hand positions. The Orchestra Edition adds the display of fingerings and positions for various orchestra instruments. All you need to do is play notes on your MIDI keyboard!

*Except for one thing: Classroom Maestro needs a little guidance in order to understand what you would like to show and how you would like to show it.*

We have designed Classroom Maestro in a way that makes it very easy and fast to let Classroom know exactly what you want to display. For example, if you want to show **S**cales, press letter **S** on your computer keyboard. When you play notes on your MIDI keyboard, notes will be shown horizontally on the screen.

On the other hand, if you want to show **C**hords, press letter **C**. Now Classroom Maestro will show notes vertically. If you want to turn on **A**nalysis, press letter **A**.

For your convenience, we provide the following pages so that you may refer to them as a quick reference as you learn the program. The first two pages show the Display Options and Keyboard Options windows where you can make your selections by clicking on them. *Note that these windows also show the keyboard shortcuts.*

The third page shows options and shortcuts that relate specifically to the orchestra instruments. The fourth page shows the Floating Tool Palette.

The last two pages of this document provide a categorical listing of all shortcuts.

We encourage you to make the effort to memorize shortcuts for the features you use frequently. Most of the shortcuts are nemonic. It's easy to remember **S** for **S**cales and **C** for **C**hords. Right?


